
CLARE WEEKS THEATRE, AUTOPATHOGRAPHY AND THE MEDICALISED SELF

Theatre, autopathography and the medicalised self is a creative response to a diagnosis of Multiple Sclerosis in 2011 and its complex presence - both aesthetic and sensory - in the artist's life.

By testing the limits of the studio and a variety of medical environments, abjection, loss, beauty and order are reperformed by the body and reframed by the lens, the screen and the page. The prognosis is a subjective and yet visually critical autographic portrait of illness, health and self.
